## LOCATION

Nestled 155 km from Bandaranaike International Airport, Jetwing Lighthouse is perfectly positioned along Sri Lanka's stunning southern coastline. The journey, whether along the scenic coastal road or the highway, offers an enchanting experience, with the former taking approximately 3 hours and 30 minutes, and the latter a more direct 2 hours and 30 minutes.

## THEMED SUITES – FA-HSIEN SUITE



